



GRILL INSTRUCTIONS:

(Please start grill about 10 minutes prior to your event—use outdoors only)
(Confirm that all 8 propane valves are closed before starting)

1. Attach the hose tightly to the propane tank leading to the grill and turn on the propane tank.
2. Wait a few minutes for the propane to move through the pipes.
3. Open the valve (located on front of grill) closest to where the hose enters the grill to allow the gas to start flowing. (Only one valve at a time!)
4. Stand back from the grill and light the grill, preferably with a long handled butane lighter gun or fireplace match.
5. Continue to open each valve to the right one-at-a-time until each are lit.
6. The entire grill should be lit at this point and ready to cook.

Troubleshooting:

If the grill does not seem to be lighting, close all valves and the propane tank, disconnect the propane from the hose to grill and reconnect it making sure it locks in tightly.

Follow the instructions and restart making sure to open one valve and light only one burner at a time.

DO NOT TURN TANKS ON THEIR SIDE. THIS WILL BLOCK THE FLOW OF THE PROPANE. IF TANK IS TURNED OR JOSTLED LET SIT 15 MINUTES TO RESET SAFETYS.
